

# NOTIFYING THE PUBLIC OF RIGHTS UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)

In accordance with the requirements of Title I of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), Harbor House of Louisville, Inc. will not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability in its services, programs, or activities.

Harbor House of Louisville, Inc. does not discriminate on the basis of disability in its provision of transportation services and complies with all regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) under Title I of the ADA.

Harbor House of Louisville, Inc. will make all reasonable modifications to policies and programs to ensure that people with disabilities have an equal opportunity to enjoy all of its programs, services, and activities.
