This service is provided through the SCL waiver for participants that do not live in a staffed residence. CLS services are goal-oriented & person-centered. CLS staff works one-on-one with the participant in the community. CLS staff provides the participant with training and/or assistance with skills that they would like to achieve. Activities include personal goals, education, recreation, or social skills.


